Having retired from the school system, Jan wanted to give something back to the school. We enlisted the support of Wharton High School and Plant City High School and agreed that 12 students from each school, chosen by faculty members for having turned their lives around in some way (i.e., better grades, attendance, overall positive attitude, etc.) would each receive \$150 to spend as they wished.



This tradition continues today. In 2011 we added Pasco High School in Dade City. Similarly, 12 PHS students were selected by faculty to receive a \$200 gift card.
