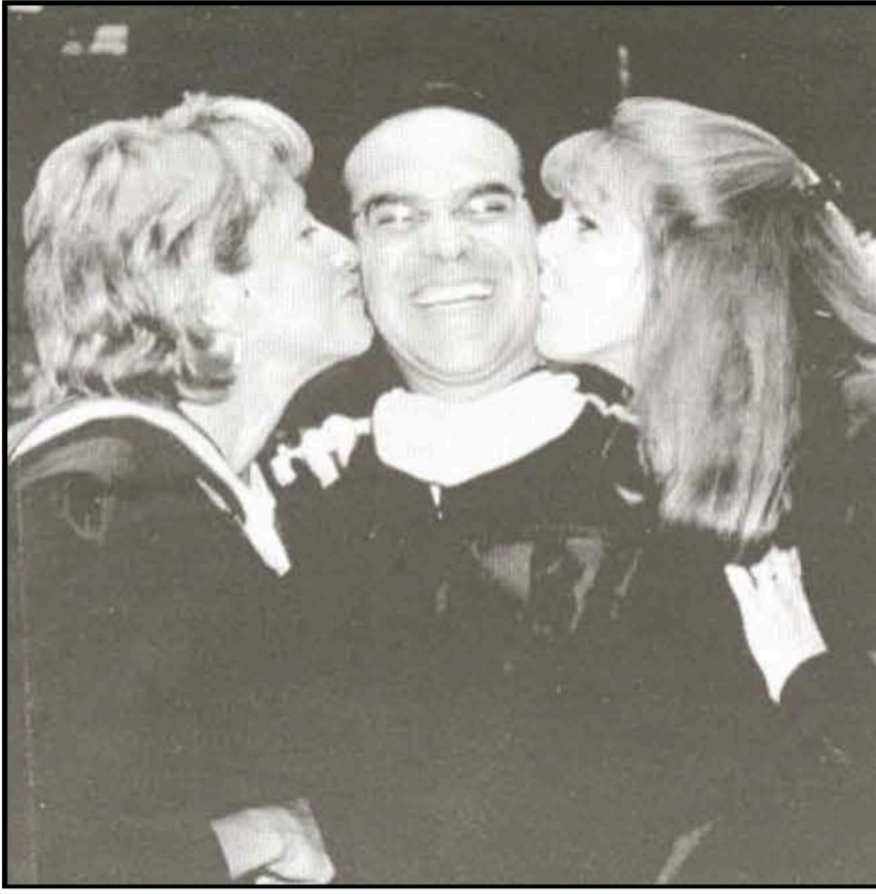


THE JAN HENRICK ACHIEVEMENT

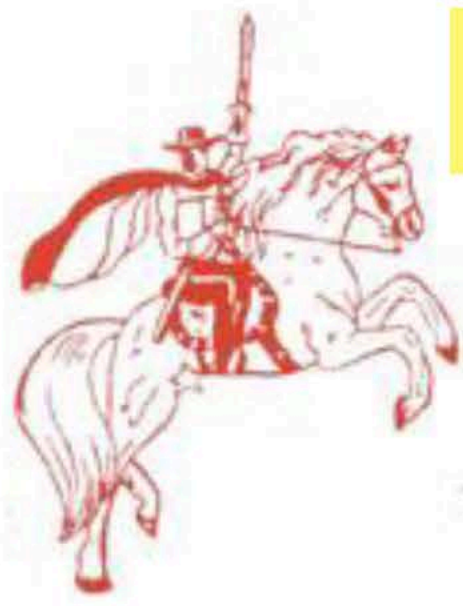

PLANT CITY — Twelve Plant City High School students have been named recipients of an award established in honor of an educator who died in 2004.

The students won the Jan Henrick Achievement Award, established in 2002, two years before her death after a battle with cancer. Henrick was a guidance counselor and swim coach in the Plant City area before working in Tampa area schools until her 2001 retirement.

This award is based on teacher nominations and recognizes students who have overcome obstacles to achieve better grades or reach other goals, said the school's college and career counselor, Sherrie Mueller.


Thank you so much for remembering Caminiti Exceptional Center with the contribution of \$1,200 towards equipment for our special needs students.

We have taken the money and purchased additional "large therapy balls" with a rack for storage. These balls can be used for balance, exercise, ball play, and body positioning. They are much sturdier than other balls so they will accommodate smaller and larger body types. We purchased more sensory equipment such as sensory balls that light up when squeezed, a light that reacts to touch, as well as wrist bells for our blind students. We also purchased jumbo speed stacking cups. These cups improve hand eye coordination and reaction time!

Once again, thank you for thinking of us and our special needs students. These items are costly and we would not be able to provide as many activities in our classes without your financial assistance. We know Jan would love doing these activities with this equipment and watching the expressions on the students' faces!
