This year marks the 10 year anniversary of Jan leaving this earth. Even though she isn't here, her legacy lives on. Amazingly, the job Jan had as high school counselor and her emphasis on helping students graduate is exactly the philosophy that guides our organization.

Being the parent of a high school sophomore, I asked for his observations regarding our event. I might mention that my stepson has numerous advantages and opportunities in life that none of the Jan Henrick recipients have. He described the golf tournament and awards ceremony as "a real eye opener." Having been to the first golf tournament seven years ago, he couldn't believe how much the charity had grown. As he and his brother greeted all 34 students and their parents, he saw how much more it meant than "just a \$150.00 gift card" to be there that evening. He witnessed parents beaming with pride, and their sons and daughters humbled by all the attention being focused on them.

"For the nominees, it gives them a beacon of hope and shows them and their parents that people do care about them." It was a proud moment for me when I read my son's response and realized that he does understand how important it is to give back to our community.

The other interesting observation was, "People are watching everything we do." Young adults need guidance. What we as parents and teachers need to do is somehow recognize and reward their efforts. Lastly, he mentioned the "nice golfers and that they do care about others." Eventually, if my son takes up golf, he will quickly realize that there is no such thing as "nice golfers."

Thanks again to all of our sponsors and everyone who participated in last year's Jan Henrick Achievement Awards.

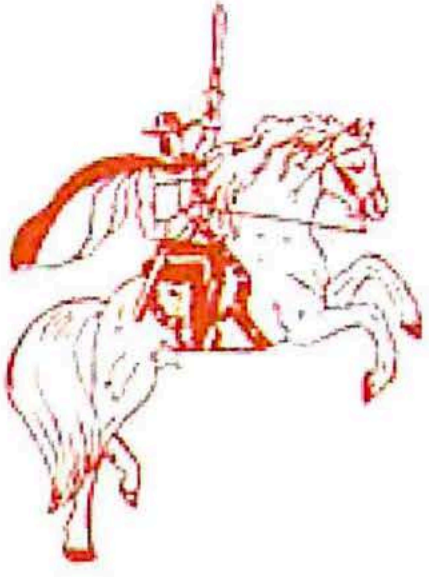
