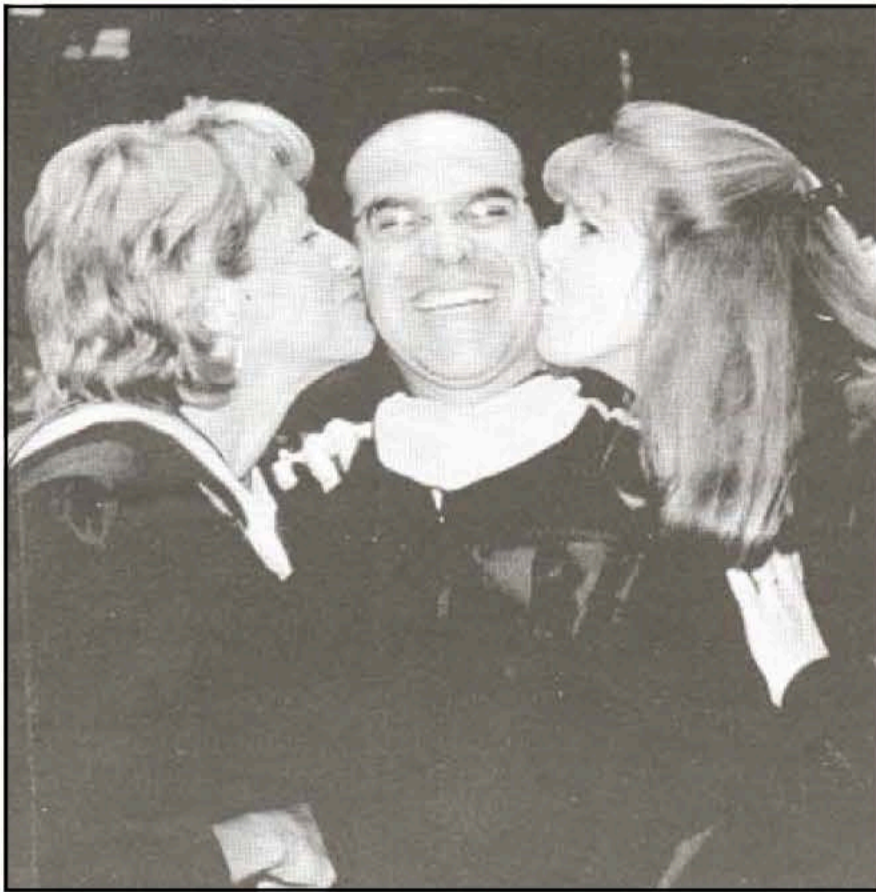




The Jan Henrick Achievement Award

Senior Mauricio Downer Jr., one of the 12 winners of this year's Jan Henrick's Award, possesses all the characteristics of a leader. Originally from Queens, NY, and the oldest brother of six younger sisters, Downer seems to always choose the right thing to do even when no one is looking.
